1. 2. In the framework of E&T Global Programing each discipline is to be assigned with a Requirements Authority and a Department Head and be addressed through a programmatic approach defined by a Strategic Training Plan (STP), Training Requirements Analysis (TRA) and Training Needs Analysis (TNA). This is to ensure that all NATO requirements are met with most appropriate training solutions. As of now, with regard to Building Integrity, some important steps forward have been made, with the approval of the STP last year and TRA.

3. Considering the above mentioned progress and developments within the area Building Integrity, the preliminary results of the TRA and the foreseen definition of NATO E&T landscape for BI, the two courses provided by your institution are eligible for accreditation as follows:
